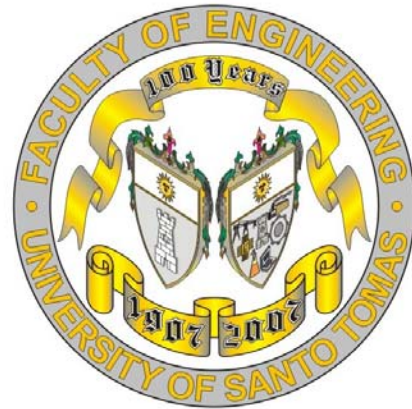


Beyond the 2007 Centennial

About the Centennial Fund

The UST Engineering Centennial Fund is a perpetual fund to support the developmental projects of the UST Faculty of Engineering and the UST Engineering Alumni Association. Inc. (USTEAAI)

All donations to the fund shall be placed in a special account of the USTEAAI and only the accumulated interest of the fund shall be used to finance the developmental projects.

A Special Board composed of the incumbent Dean of the Faculty of Engineering, incumbent President of the USTEAAI, and three other alumni selected by the incumbent USTEAAI Board shall serve as caretaker of the Fund.

Centennial Fund Seed Money

A seed money of at least P5,000,000 (5M Pesos) is targeted by 2007, the centennial year of the foundation of the UST Faculty of Engineering. This will hopefully initially generate an annual interest enough to support the identified developmental projects.

Hence after, the Centennial Fund is envisioned to be continuously improved annually through renewal of pledges or new donations during homecomings and other USTEAAI events.

Developmental Projects

The following developmental projects have been initially identified by the USTEAAI for support by the Centennial Fund:

1. Faculty Thesis or Dissertation Completion Supplemental Grant
2. e-Learning Academe-Alumni Partnership Program (e-LeA²P²) Implementation Grant
3. Grants for Faculty-Initiated Continuing Professional Education (CPE) Seminars and Workshops
4. Logistics for promoting the Industry-Academe Linkage Program (IALP) of the Faculty.

Annual project proposals shall be submitted to the USTEAAI for approval or renewal before any amount could be granted out of the Centennial Fund.

Projected Benefits

The Centennial Fund is envisioned to improve the following Key Performance Indicators (KPIs):

1. Percentage of Faculty with Advanced Engineering Degrees
2. Percentage of Engineering Faculty Implementing Web-Enhanced Courses
3. Annual number of alumni participating in Web-Enhanced Courses
4. Annual number of faculty and alumni participating in faculty-initiated CPE Seminars and Workshops
5. Annual Number of Memoranda of Understanding (MOU) generated by the IALP.

An annual report shall be submitted by the managers of all approved projects to the USTEAAI Board.
